Survey Report

I. Background

As part of the ongoing long-range planning effort at Christ the King, a Parish-Wide Survey was conducted on the weekend of September 25th – 26th, 2010. Surveys were distributed at all Masses during that weekend to all in attendance. These surveys were designed to gather information on parishioners' overall feelings about Christ the King, and gauge the parish's areas of strength and opportunity.

The surveys were sent to the Institute of School and Parish Development (ISPD) in New Orleans, LA. ISPD is the consulting firm that is presently working with Christ the King in a strategic planning process. ISPD tallied the results – dividing the survey into the following components:

- 5:30 p.m. Saturday Mass results
- 7:00 a.m. Sunday Mass results
- 8:30 a.m. Sunday Mass results
- 11:00 a.m. Sunday Mass results
- Website results
- Lightkeeper results
- Composite of all Completed Surveys

II. Clarification

There were a total of 913 surveys that were tabulated by ISPD. The survey instrument was straightforward in what was being asked; there were six areas in which to respond:

- The parish's communication effort regarding news, activities and volunteer and ministry opportunities;
- Ministry and social, educational and spiritual opportunities for parishioners;
- Adequacy of parish buildings and facilities;
- Level of parish staffing;
- Ministry and social needs of parish children, youth and young adults;
- Personal participation in parish ministries;
- Additional comments.

III. Overall Survey Results

Below is a summary of the overall survey results for Christ the King. The ISPD

perspective points out highlights and trends in each area, and offers insight for the Steering Committee and other parish leaders to utilize as they move forward in the strategic planning process.

Age breakdown for parishioners completing the survey:

- Ages 12-19 16%
- Ages 20-29 4%
- Ages 30-44 24%
- Ages 45-59 30%
- Ages 60+ 23%
- No response 3%

Feelings about the parish communication effort regarding news and activities:

- 86% indicated that they agree to strongly agree that Christ the King does an excellent job in this area.
- 9% were neutral.
- 3% indicated that they disagree to strongly disagree that Christ the King does an excellent job in this area.
- 2% had no response.

Feelings about the parish communication effort regarding ministry and volunteer opportunities and needs:

- 76% indicated that they agree to strongly agree that Christ the King does an excellent job in this area.
- 15% were neutral.
- 5% indicated that they disagree to strongly disagree that Christ the King does an excellent job in this area.
- 4% had no response.

ISPD perspective

- △ Overall, parishioners feel that Christ the King does a good job communicating parish news and activities, but has an opportunity to improve the communication effort with regard to ministry and volunteer opportunities and needs.
- △ Though Christ the King offers forty-two ministries for involvement, there are still some members who are unaware of that fact.
- △ Respondents offered many ways to improve the communication effort including:
 - Personalizing the communication effort
 - Establishing a dedicated communication volunteer or staff

- position
 - Better utilizing technology
 - Parish website
 - E-mail
 - Social networking
 - Texting
- △ Respondents also indicated a need for CTK to improve communication among the various ministries to avoid conflicts and overlaps in programs, schedules, etc.
- △ ISPD recommends that the Steering Committee include communication as a Challenge to be discussed within the Development & Stewardship group of the Parish Planning Team and incorporated into the overall long-range advancement plan for Christ the King.
- △ Establishing an overall parish communication plan would be beneficial for Christ the King. Creating a standard of communication that can be applied with consistency will provide the parish with a strong foundation for excellence in development now and in the future.
- △ In ISPD's experience, having a central person serve as a clearinghouse for all outgoing communication (electronic, written, and verbal) is important in maintaining consistency, accuracy and accountability. This function would traditionally fall under the responsibility of a Development Director.

Feelings about Christ the King serving the educational and spiritual needs of the parish:

- 86% agree to strongly agree that Christ the King successfully serves the parish's educational and spiritual needs.
- 8% were neutral.
- 3% disagree to strongly disagree that Christ the King successfully serves the parish's educational and spiritual needs.
- 3% had no response.

Feelings about Christ the King serving the ministry and social needs of the parish:

- 78% agree to strongly agree that Christ the King successfully serves the parish's ministry and social needs.
- 13% were neutral.
- 4.5% disagree to strongly disagree that Christ the King successfully serves the parish's ministry and social needs.
- 4.5% had no response.

ISPD perspective

- △ There is widespread approval among parishioners regarding Christ the King's educational, spiritual, ministry and social activities.
- △ One recurring theme throughout the survey data was the idea of offering more options for education, ministry, social and spiritual activities to accommodate work schedules.
- △ Additionally, the idea of a disconnect between parishioners involved with the parish school and those who are not is another theme that surfaced in the survey results. This is an area of opportunity for the Family Life and Education groups of the Parish Planning Team to further discuss and incorporate into the long-range advancement plan for CTK.
- △ Respondents offered suggestions for improvement in each of the four areas:
 - Educational
 - Introducing adult education/classes between the Masses on Sundays (8-11 am)
 - Offering additional opportunities for bible studies
 - Pursuing the idea of a Baldwin County Catholic High School
 - Offering family financial planning (Dave Ramsey)
 - Spiritual
 - Offering longer or varied times for confession
 - Ministry
 - Forming an adult group or club for members ages 50+
 - Establishing a new facility for youth
 - Social
 - Planning young adult gatherings
 - Offering additional social activities in general

Feelings about the parish's buildings and facilities:

- 55% agree to strongly agree that the existing buildings and facilities meet parish needs.
- 16% were neutral.
- 22% disagree to strongly disagree that the existing buildings and facilities meet parish needs.
- 7% had no response.

ISPD perspective

- △ It is no surprise that a significant number of parishioners feel that the current campus and buildings do not meet the needs of the parish. The ideas of expanding, renovating, acquiring property and building have been circulating at CTK for many years. Given CTK's recent growth in parish

membership and the projection that this trend will continue, it is important for the Steering Committee to address this Challenge with the Buildings & Grounds group of the Parish Planning Team.

- △ Respondents identified many facility and campus needs in the survey. Here are some of the top suggestions:
 - Adding classrooms for school/CCD
 - Providing a cafeteria for the school
 - Building a Family Life Center
 - Providing a new facility for the youth
 - Constructing a new gym
 - Addressing the size of the church
 - Adding meeting space
 - Increasing parking
 - Acquiring land for athletic field/play use
 - Creating a plan for general maintenance and upgrades
- △ ISPD feels it would be beneficial for Christ the King to consider conducting a feasibility study and planning for a Capital Campaign effort in the future to fund some of these major facility projects.

Feelings about the level of parish staffing:

- 67% agree to strongly agree that the current level of staffing meets parish needs.
- 17% were neutral.
- 6% disagree to strongly disagree that the current level of staffing meets parish needs.
- 10% had no response.

ISPD perspective

- △ The level of parish staffing is another key area that raised concern among some parishioners at Christ the King. Anytime ISPD sees the strongly agree/agree percentage dip below 70, we feel that is an area a parish should further investigate.
- △ Respondents indicated the need for Christ the King to:
 - Increase the number of priests serving the parish
 - Establish a Development Director position
 - Establish a Music Director/Minister position
- △ These three suggestions continue to recur as themes in our long-range planning process at CTK.
- △ ISPD recommends that parish staffing be further discussed and addressed as a Challenge in the Administration & Finance group of the Parish Planning

Team.

Feelings about meeting the ministry and social needs for the children of the parish (birth – 11 years):

- 63% agree to strongly agree that the parish does a good job meeting the ministry and social needs of this age group.
- 15% were neutral.
- 5% disagree to strongly disagree that the parish does a good job meeting the ministry and social needs of this age group.
- 17% had no response.

Feelings about meeting the ministry and social needs for the youth of the parish (12-19 years):

- 50% agree to strongly agree that the parish does a good job meeting the ministry and social needs of this age group.
- 19% were neutral.
- 10% disagree to strongly disagree that the parish does a good job meeting the ministry and social needs of this age group.
- 21% had no response.

Feelings about meeting the ministry and social needs for the young adults of the parish (20-29 years):

- 30% agree to strongly agree that the parish does a good job meeting the ministry and social needs of this age group.
- 25% were neutral.
- 12% disagree to strongly disagree that the parish does a good job meeting the ministry and social needs of this age group.
- 33% had no response.

ISPD perspective

- △ Meeting the ministry and social needs for youth (12-19) and young adults (20-29) in the parish yielded significant percentages of dissatisfaction in this survey.
- △ That leads ISPD to conclude that these specific areas should be included as Challenges for Christ the King as the parish moves forward in planning for the future. The Children, Youth & Young Adult group of the Parish Planning Team can utilize these survey findings to further their discussion, articulate Challenges and develop solutions to address these needs for CTK.
- △ There were many excellent ideas offered in the comment section of the survey. Some of the top suggestions for improvement include:

- Providing an improved facility for youth
- Building a formal young adult ministry
- Adding a Lifeteen Mass on Sunday evening
- Offering more activities for these age groups in general

Personal participation in ministries at Christ the King:

- 53% indicated that they regularly participate in one or more ministries.
- 38% indicated that they do not regularly participate in one or more ministries.
- 9% had no response.

ISPD perspective

- △ From ISPD's perspective, Christ the King is on track with the national average with respect to the percentage of parishioners who are involved in ministry.
- △ The top reasons given for non-participation were:
 - Not enough time/schedule constraints
 - Work obligations
 - Having young children at home
 - Volunteering with no contact or follow-through
 - Feeling unwelcome or uncomfortable
 - Unaware of opportunities
 - Age
 - Not being interested
- △ Respondents offered many ways to improve the level of participation including:
 - Follow-through for those who offer to volunteer
 - Better communication of what's available/needed
 - Offering childcare
- △ Participation in ministry is one of the keys that we know will ultimately lead to engagement, so considering and implementing methods to increase participation will be essential for Christ the King in building it's long-range vision.
- △ Christ the King can't add more time to anyone's day, but the parish can take steps to address some of the reasons listed as deterrents to participation. ISPD would like to see the Development & Stewardship group of the Parish Planning Team further discuss this topic, and create a Challenge and develop solutions for increasing parishioner participation.

IV. Recommendations

1. ISPD recommends that parish leaders and the Steering Committee see

the results of the survey as a positive. All comments should be read, understood and filtered into the planning process.

2. The following areas should be further explored by the Steering Committee and the Parish Planning Team as they continue to build Christ the King's Long-Range Advancement Plan:
 - Overall improvement in communication with an additional focus on and ministry/volunteer opportunities and needs
 - Follow-through for people who indicate interest for involvement
 - Continued growth/establishment of Youth and Young Adult ministries
 - Offering additional activities and programs to accommodate work schedules
 - Level of parish staffing
 - Seeking ways to better welcome newcomers
 - Building the feeling of "belonging" among parishioners not involved with the parish school
 - Management of parish growth (facilities, physical plant)

3. ISPD recommends that the results of the survey be summarized for all parishioners and communicated through the following vehicles:
 - *Monthly Planning Update*
 - Parish bulletin
 - School newsletter
 - Website
 - Mass announcements
 - Father O'Connor's personal comments at Mass

4. ISPD recommends that the Steering Committee review the names of respondents who indicated interest in being further involved with this process. Additionally, each person should be personally contacted and invited to attend the parish Convocation in January.
